

Standard Rules

Check the computer readiness before the exam by visiting:

Alone in room

Clear Desk and Area

Connected to a power source

No phones, headphones, calculator or any electronic devices in the room.

No dual monitors

No leaving seat

No talking or reading aloud the questions.

Webcam, speakers, and microphone must remain on throughout the test.

Ears should be visible throughout the exam.

All open applications must be closed before start of the exam.

Allowing 360-degree view of the room for the proctor is a must.

2 A4 blank sheets and a pencil to be shown to the proctor before the exam and torn in front of the proctor before exam submission. Pens are strictly not allowed.

In the event of a computer malfunction/connectivity issue during the exam, the proctor will help/guide you to resume the exam within half an hour (30 mins) beyond which the exam will be considered as a NO show/Exam expired and you will need to schedule another attempt. The fee for this attempt will be forfeited.
